The **Human Trafficking and the State Courts Collaborative** (<http://www.htcourts.org/>) is a joint effort between national state court support and education programs, sponsored by the State Justice Institute in an effort to address human trafficking in the state courts. The HTC, formed in early 2013, is coordinated by the Center for Public Policy Studies, the National Judicial College, the Center for Court Innovation, the National Association of Women Judges, the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges, and Legal Momentum.

The HTC is “dedicated to increasing awareness and understanding about the prevalence in the United States through the Human Trafficking and the State Courts Collaborative website.” Its website is “one facet of the ongoing work of the HTC and is designed to provide up-to-date information, reports, statistics, and tools that will help justice system policymakers, practitioners, and researchers more effectively address human trafficking issues.”
